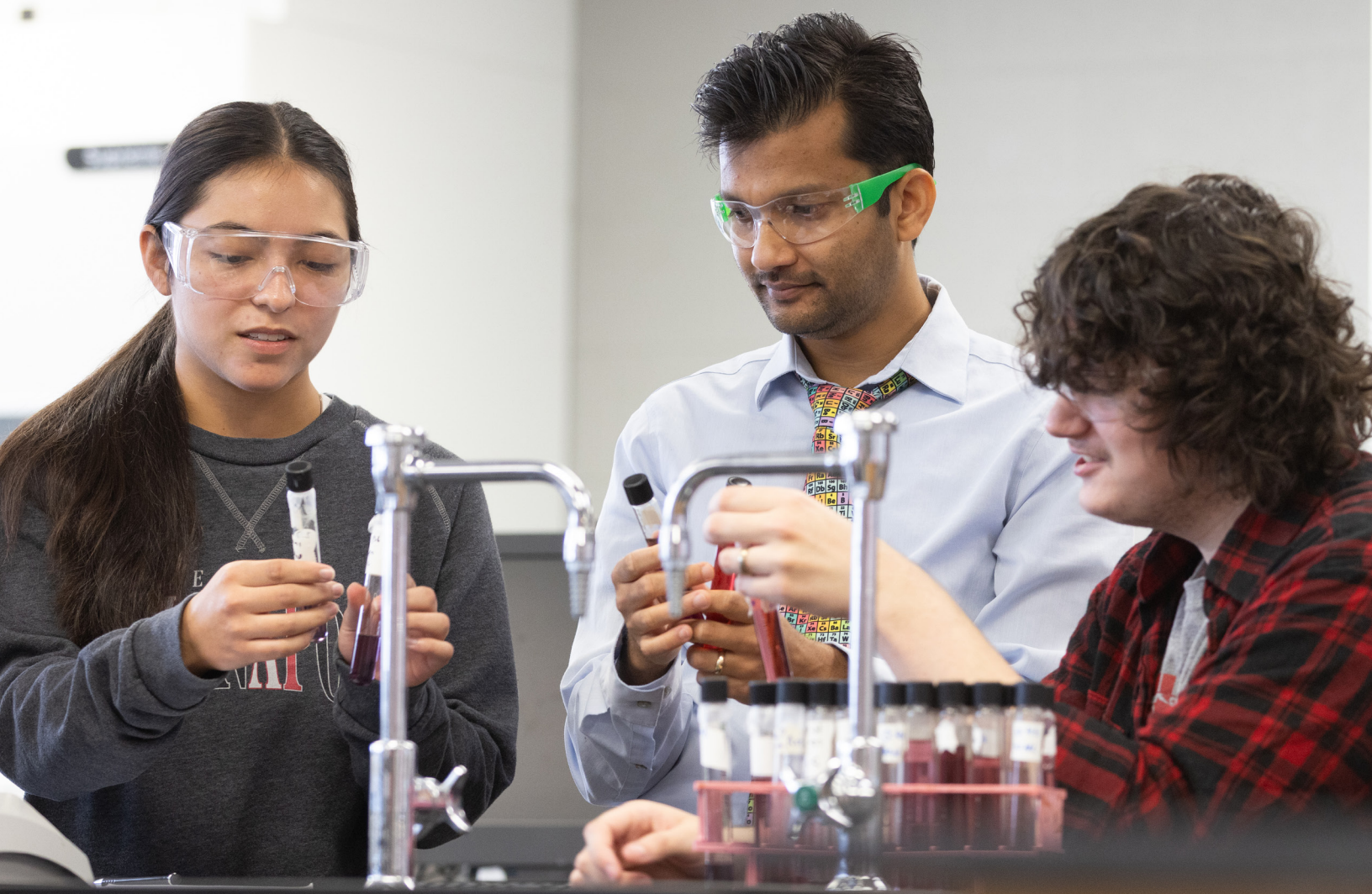

UNDERGRADUATE ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS



\$12,000 TO \$20,000 PER YEAR FOR INCOMING FRESHMAN: (no previous post-secondary studies) - based on high school grade point average.

\$5,000 TO \$17,000 PER YEAR FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS: based on post-secondary average grades from all post-secondary institutions attended.

At the point of admission, undergraduate students with no previous bachelor's degree are automatically considered for one of these academic scholarships. For athletic grant consideration, please make direct contact with the coaching staff of your sport.

Students should also submit course descriptions in English.

ADMISSION DETAILS

How do I submit documents?

Detailed instructions will be emailed to you after you submit an admission application. We can often make a provisional admission decision based on documents uploaded to your application portal.

How do I finalize my admission?

To finalize your admission you'll need to submit official, paper academic documents (stamped & signed by the issuing institution or an educational authority) and have official examination results sent directly to us from the examination service.

When are your intakes and deadlines?

We have intakes every year in August and January. While we continue accepting applications until we reach capacity or until you run out of time to complete the process, we strongly suggest that you apply several months in advance.
