## FIND YOUR "WHY"

- What are your interests and strengths?
- What challenges or issues in the world do you care about?
- How might you connect those to possible career paths or goals?

### Option A: Speak to an Advisor

Discuss why your current major isn't the right fit (what you don't like, your strengths, etc.) and consider better options with your Academic Advisor, Faculty Advisor, or Career Coach.

## 1. CHECK THE NEW MAJOR'S CLASSES WITH DEGREEWORKS

- Log in to DegreeWorks and select the "What-If" tool (top box).
- Choose your new major (and optional minor/concentration) and click "Process."
- **Important:** Scroll to the new major section and click the blue course links to read descriptions.
- Ask yourself: Do these classes match my interests and strengths?

### Things to Watch For:

- **Pre-Med** is a concentration, not a major.
- **500-level courses** mean you selected a graduate program—try again.
- **Modern language requirement:** Ignore this on the What-If report; it requires advisor interpretation.

## 2. FIND YOUR NEW ADVISOR

- Visit the Advisors by Major page to see who advises your new program.

## 3. SCHEDULE A MAJOR CHANGE APPOINTMENT

Meet with the new advisor to:

- Discuss your interest and complete the Major Change Request form.
- Adjust upcoming courses.
- Get your Registration PIN (if needed).
  - If registration is within the next two weeks, ask your new advisor for your PIN.
  - If you're planning ahead, contact your primary advisor once DegreeWorks updates.
