




A Small University





Orientation




Of Mice And Men







Pippin

The Cherry Orchard



Anton Chekhov's *The Cherry Orchard* deals with the life-like drama of loss, gain and renewal in a change of life. Mme. Lyuboff Andreyevna, a wealthy Russian heiress, travels to France to forget the deaths of her husband and son. She returns to her cherry orchard virtually broke due to her extravagance. In an all-too-short period of time, she leaves her final property, the orchard, to the grandson of a former servant.

This classic work was banned in Russia because the government realized that Chekhov was predicting the rise of a new regime.


Ski Weekend




Robyn Selected As Miss ICU


The More Things Change The More They Stay The Same Where We've Been

The Board of Trustees gave general approval for these two buildings more than a year ago. Since that time, some quiet planning has been going on. Architects have prepared tentative floor plans for a new gymnasium and student activity building, and for a new auditorium, administration and classroom building. These two buildings are designed for the utmost in utility of function and at the same time to give an appearance which will add beauty to the campus.

Present plans call for the gymnasium and student activity building to be the first on the list. It is to serve as a memorial and honor hall for United Brethren service men and women in this area. The floor plan calls for a gymnasium of such size that, by means of a center sliding door, it can serve for two gymnasiums, one for men and one for women, during the normal week-day class programs. Then it can be opened and a center court used for inter-collegiate games. It is to have a swimming pool under the gym floor and so arranged that the showers and lockers will serve both for the gym and the pool.


At the recent special meeting of our Board of Trustees, several significant actions were taken which are now being implemented:





New And Renew






The junior varsity also was impressive. The pups ended the season with a 9-2 record. They managed to beat the two teams who had beaten them in rematches.








Hooding Ceremony Baccalaureate Highlight






Seventy-Fourth Annual Commencement
