Ted Polk stays cool and collected despite the heat from the grill. As always, Ted and his staff did an outstanding job of preparing enough food to feed hundreds of people.

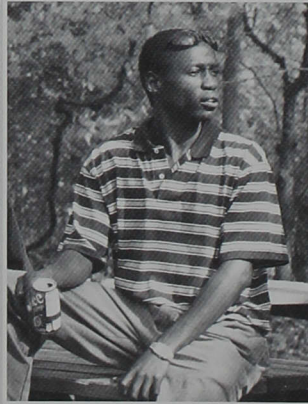

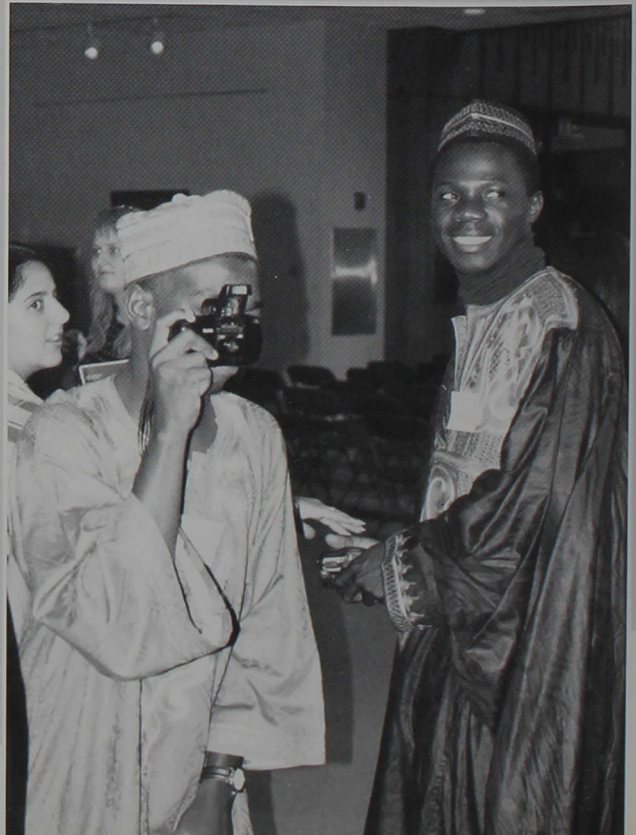

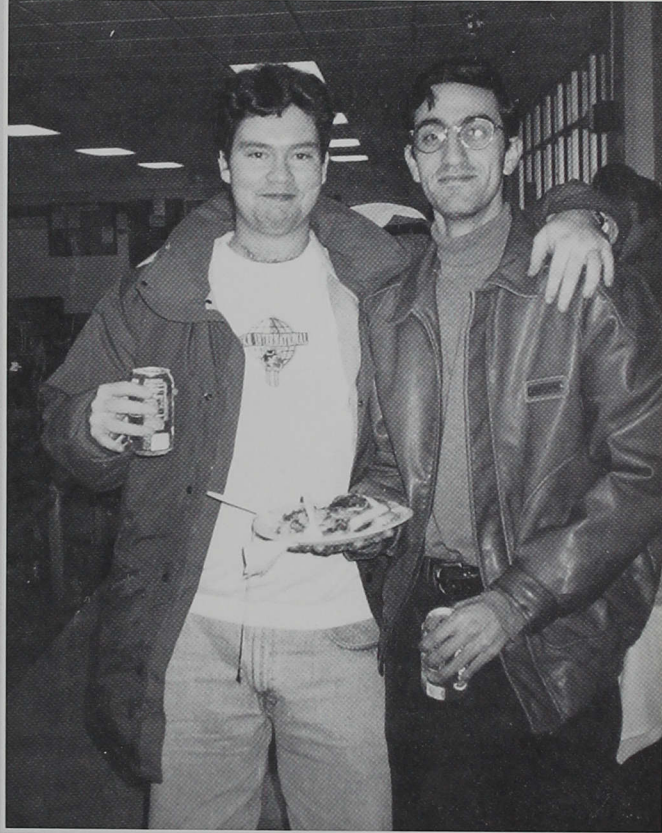
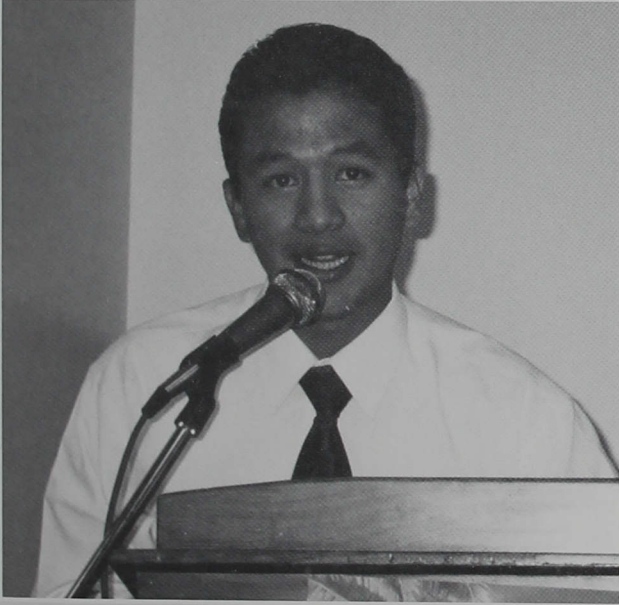

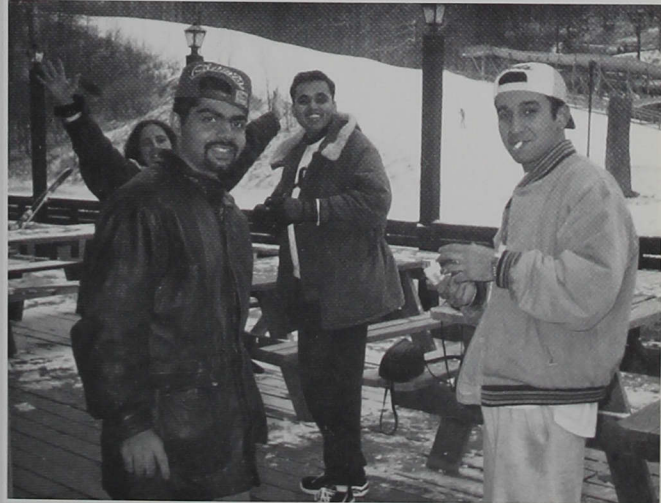

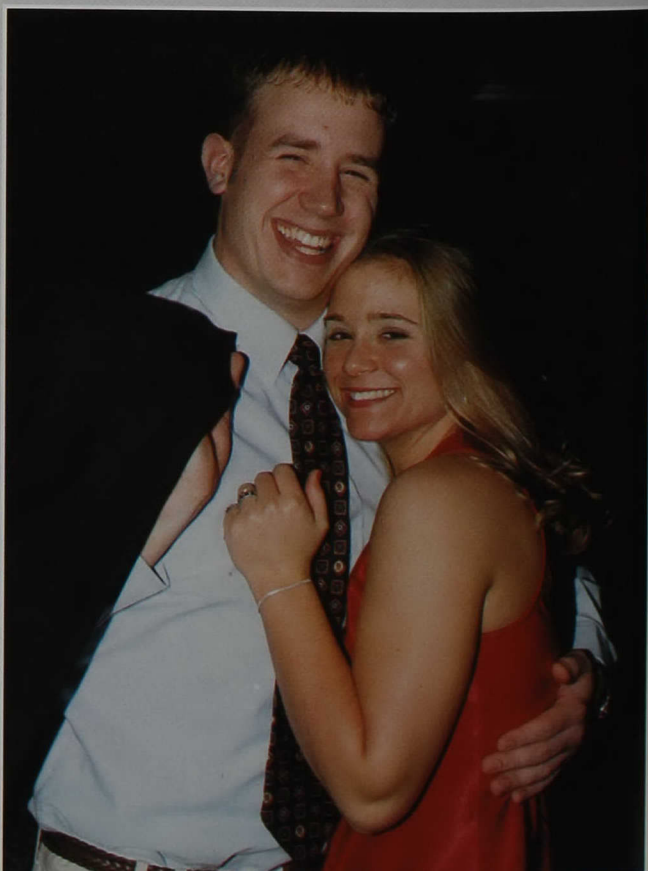

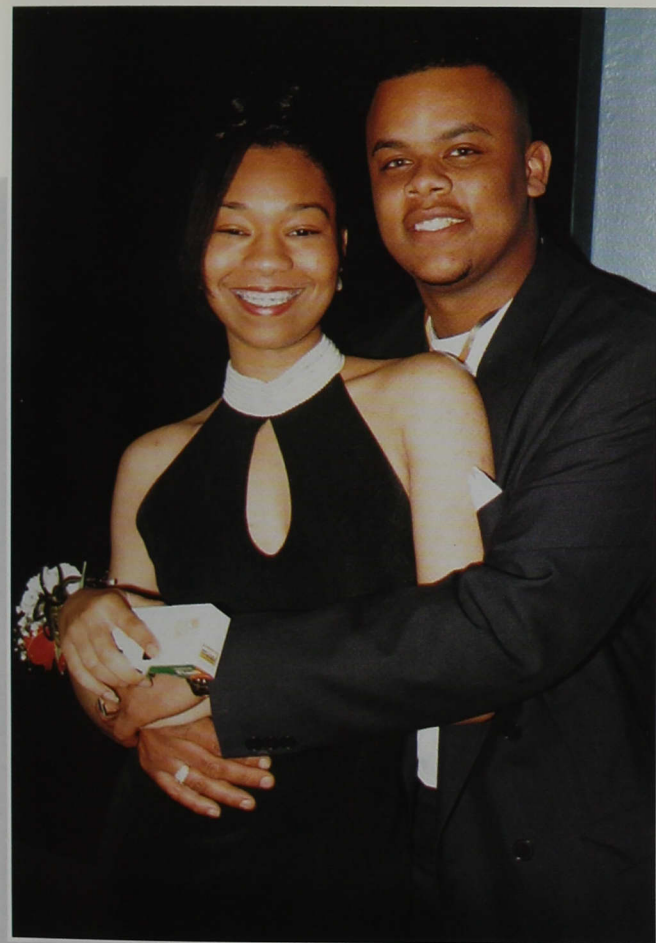

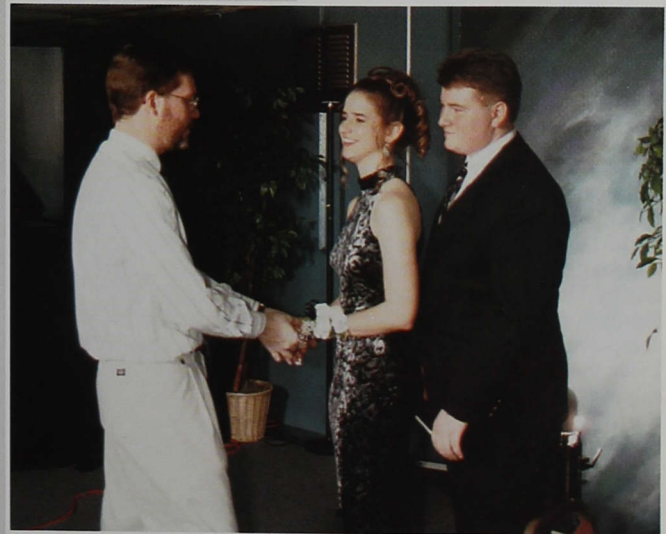

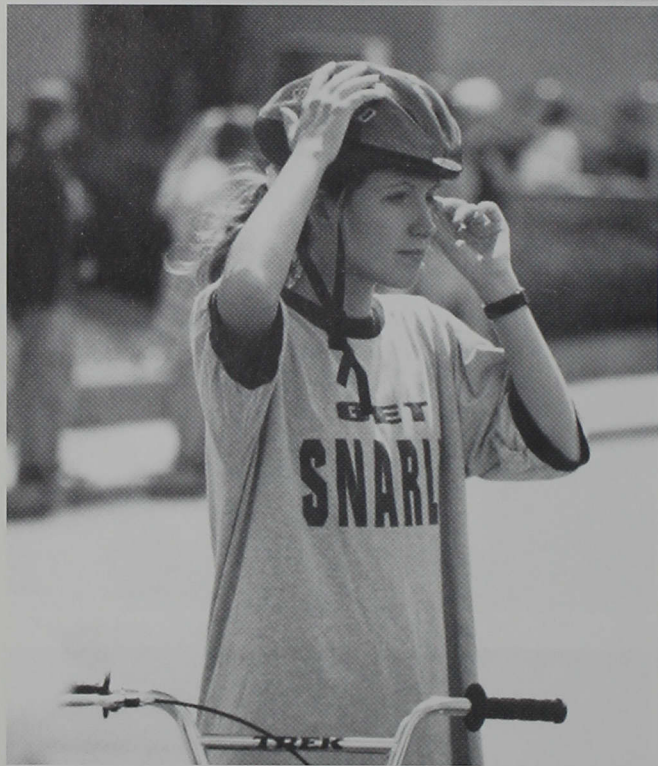

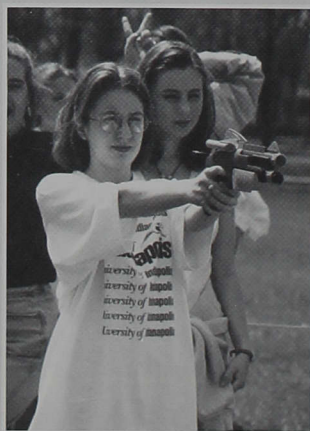

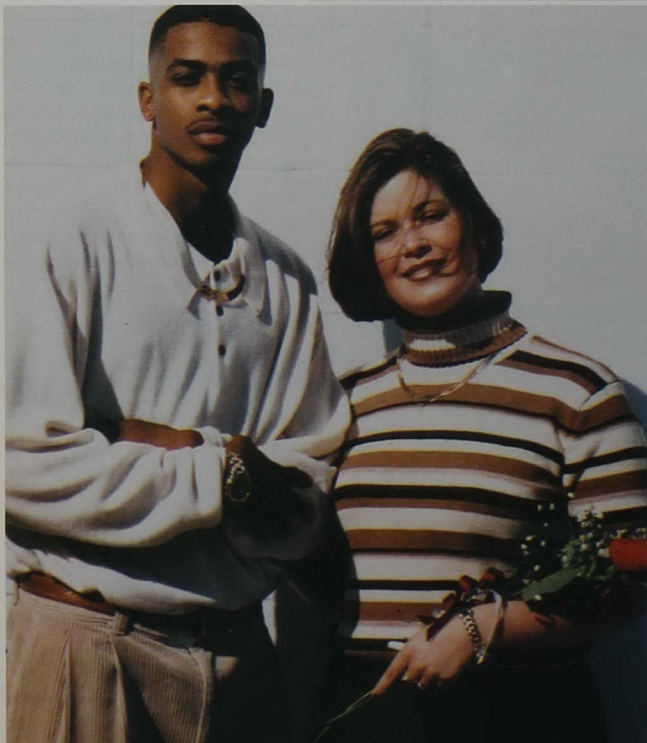

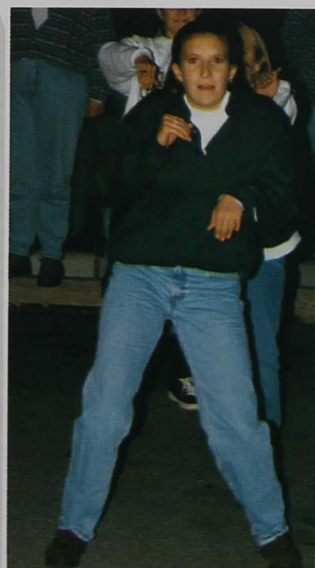

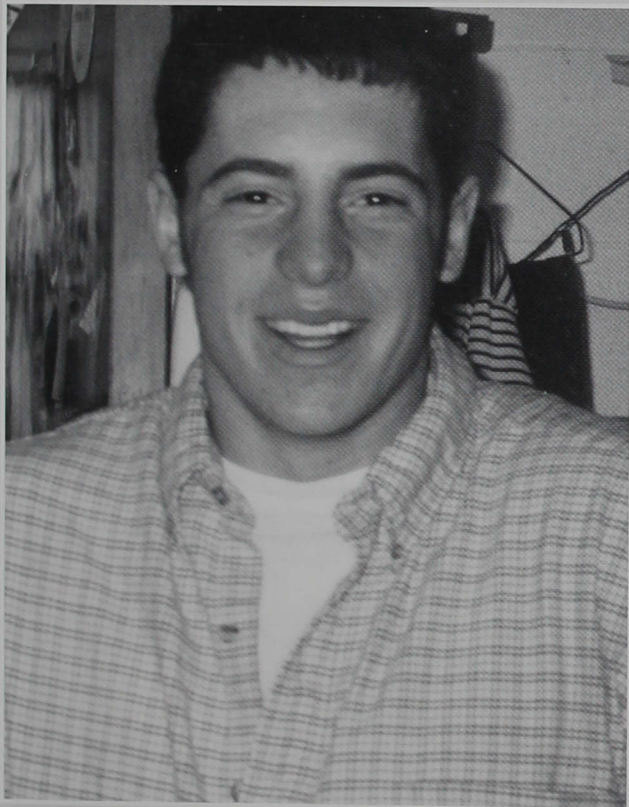

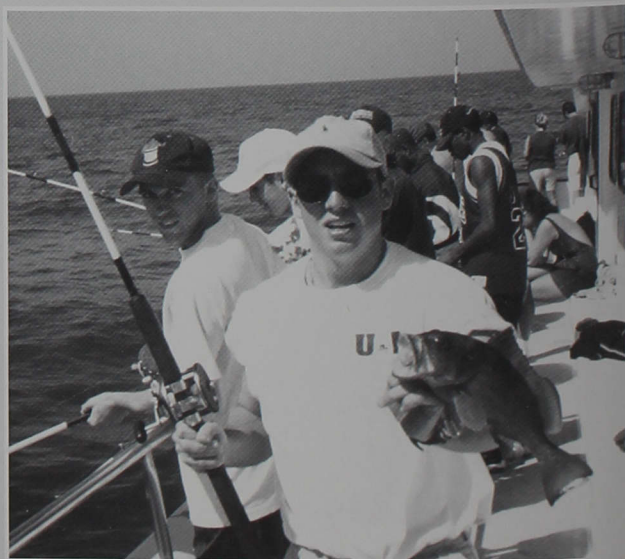

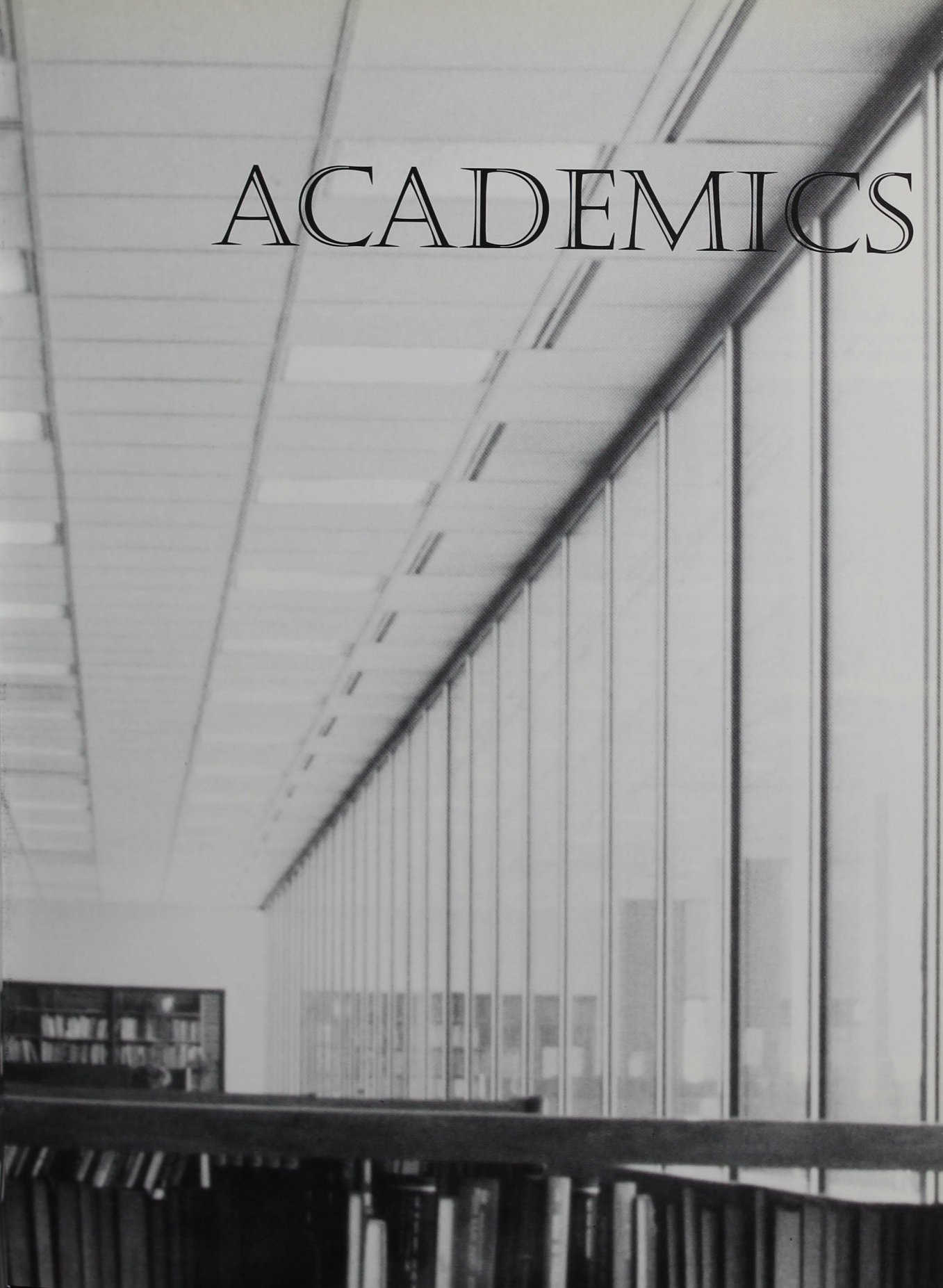

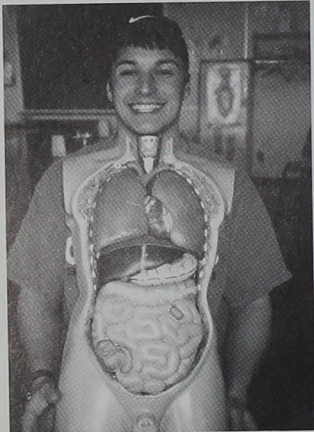

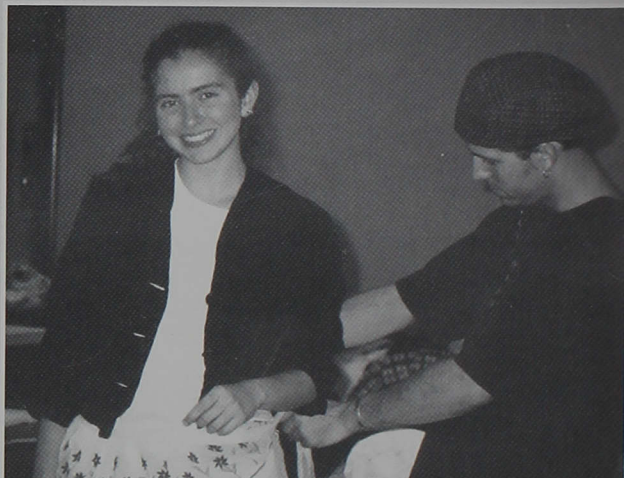

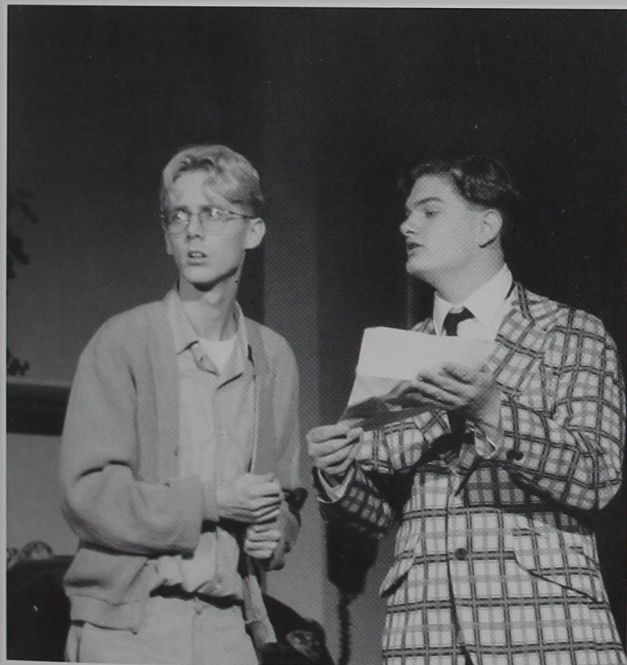

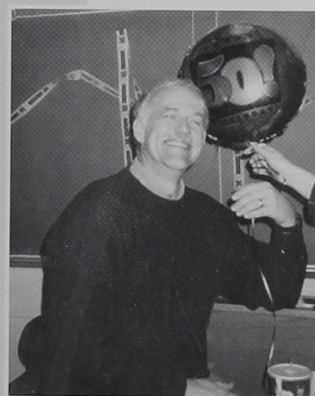
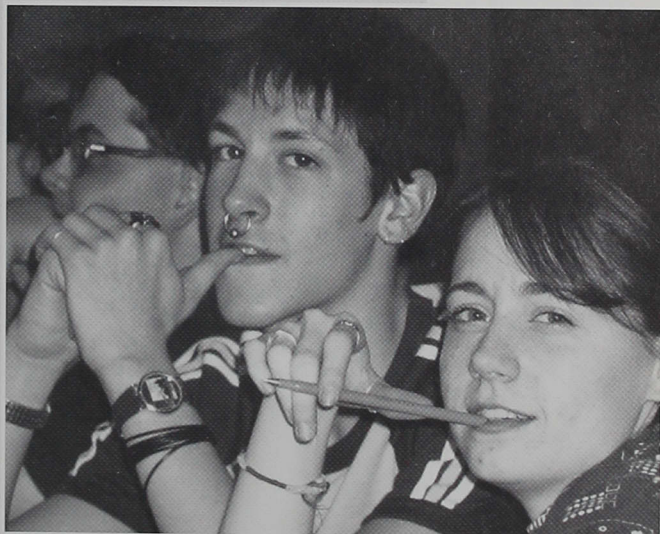

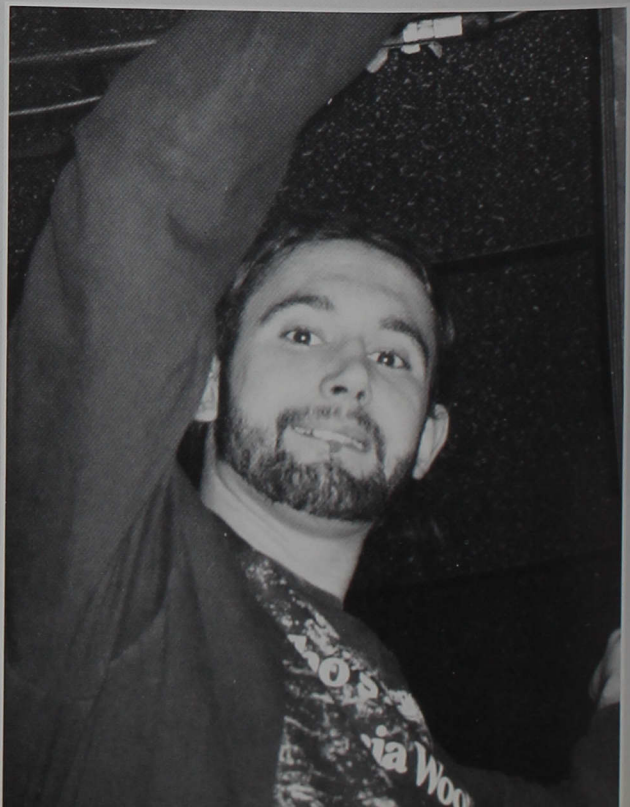

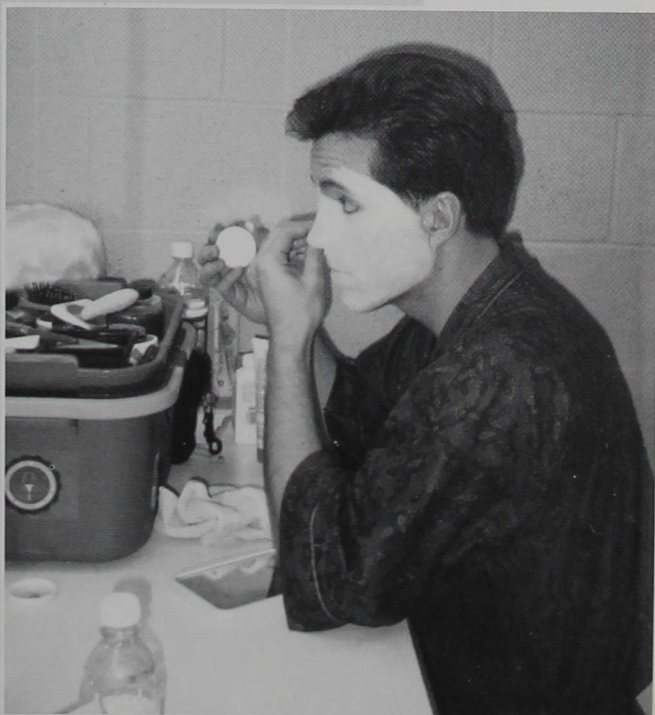

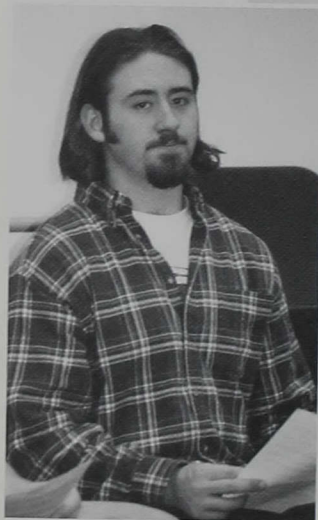

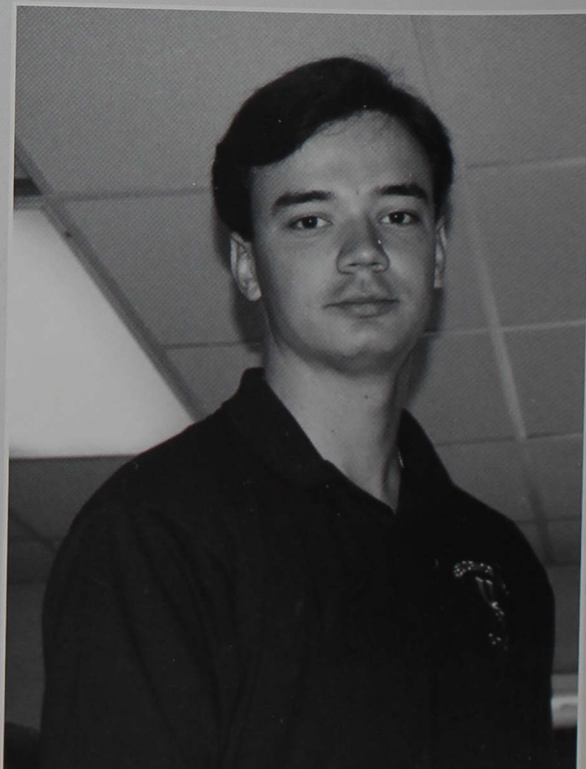

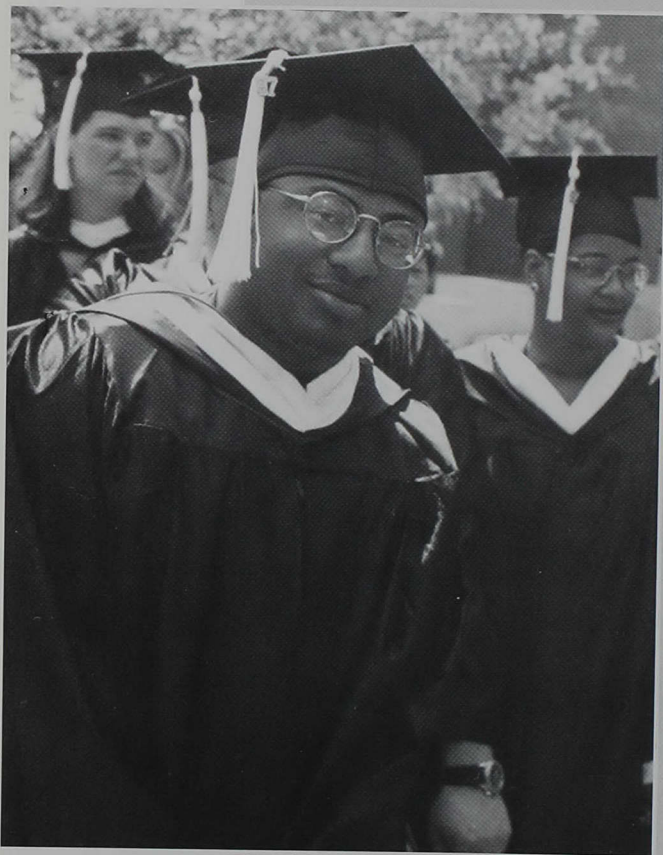

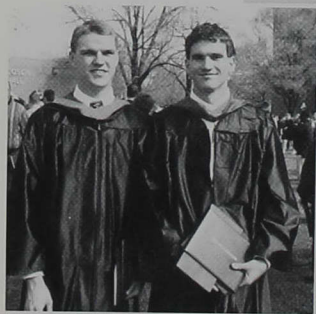

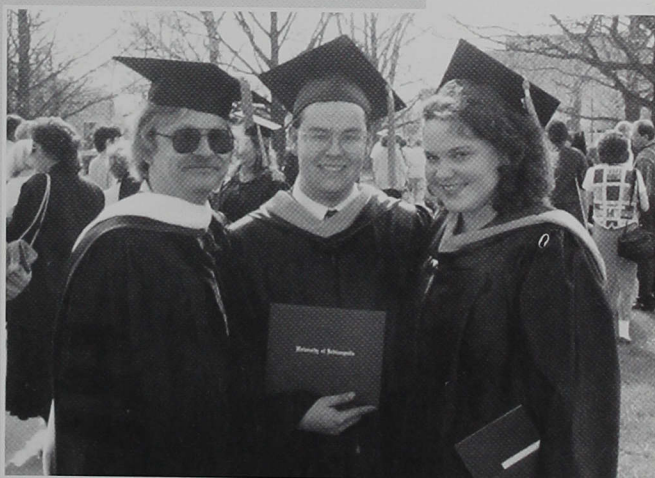

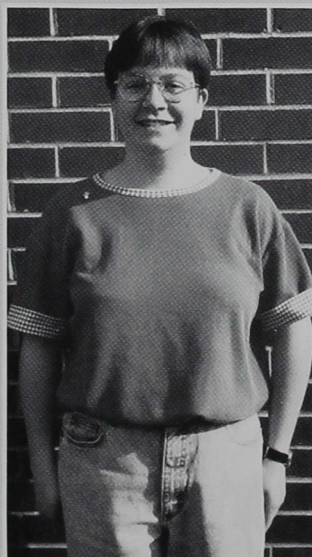

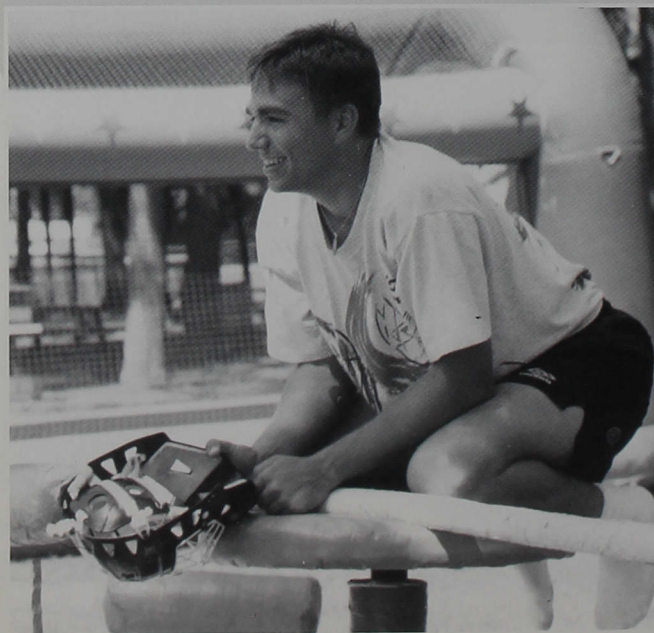

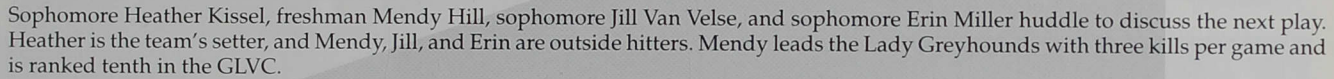

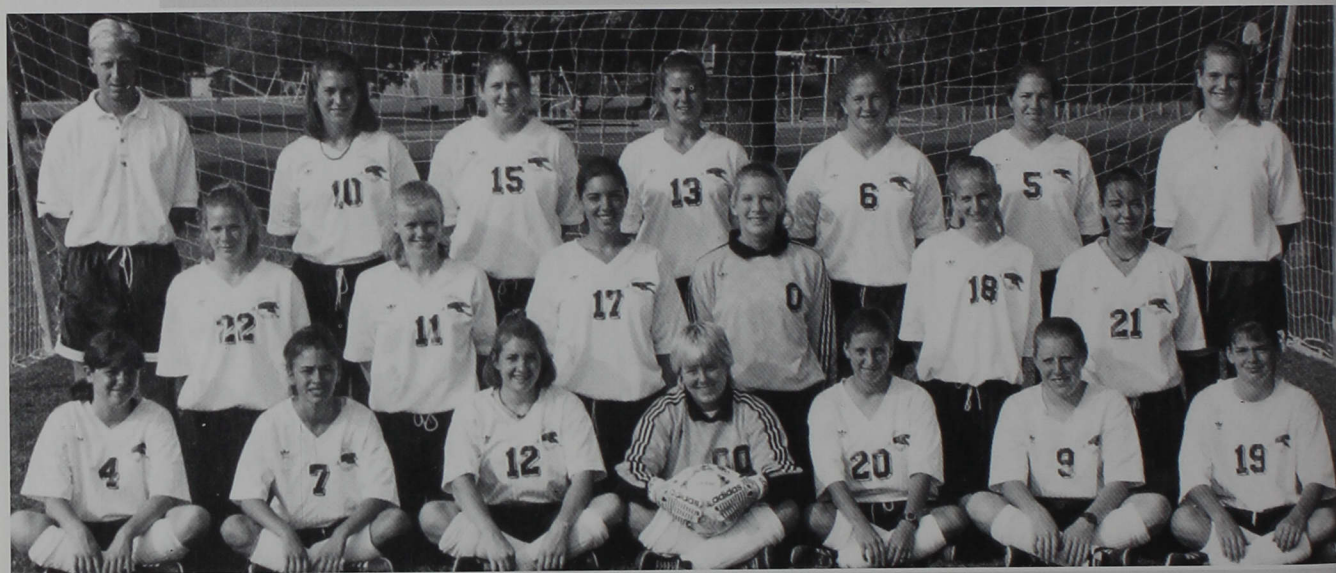

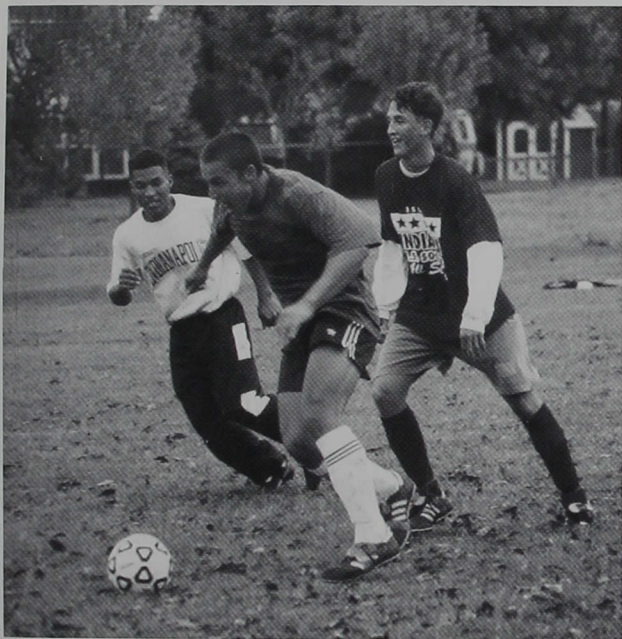

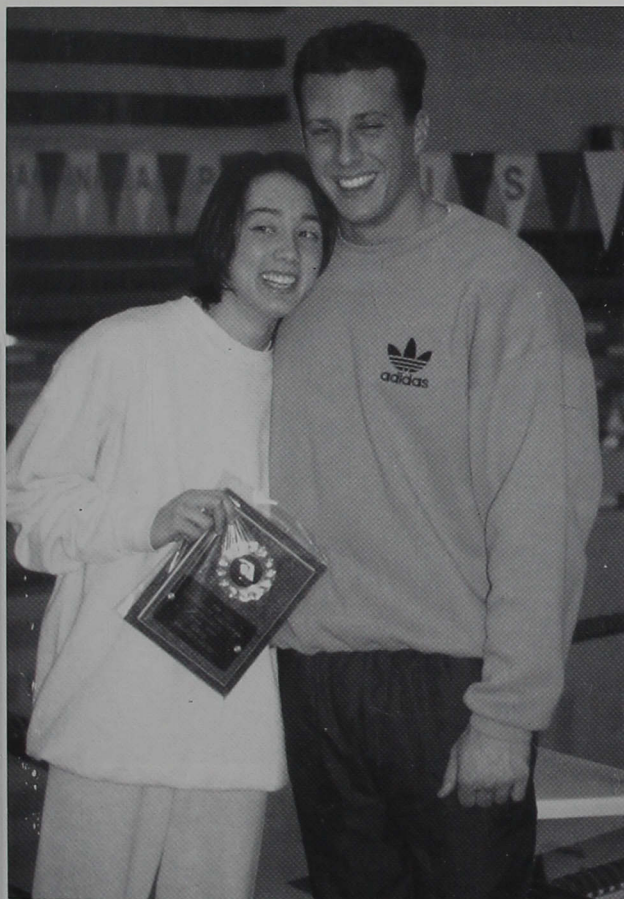

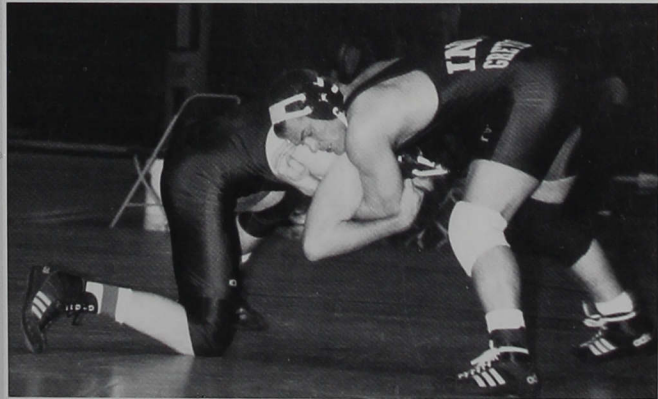

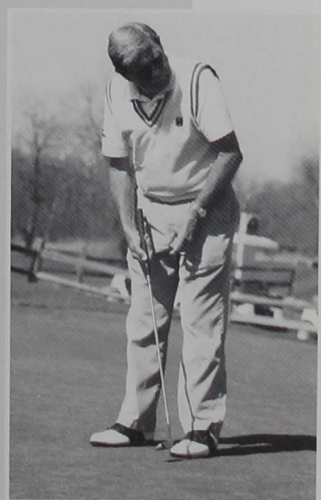

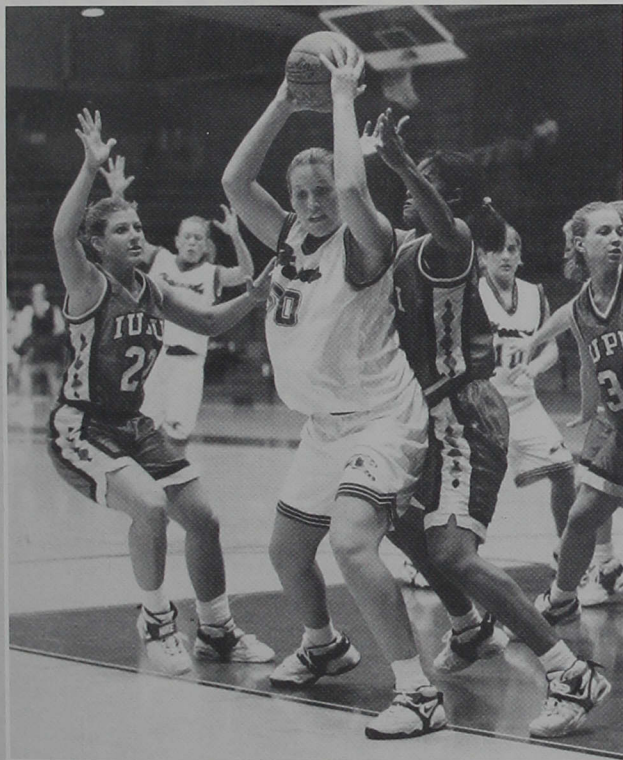

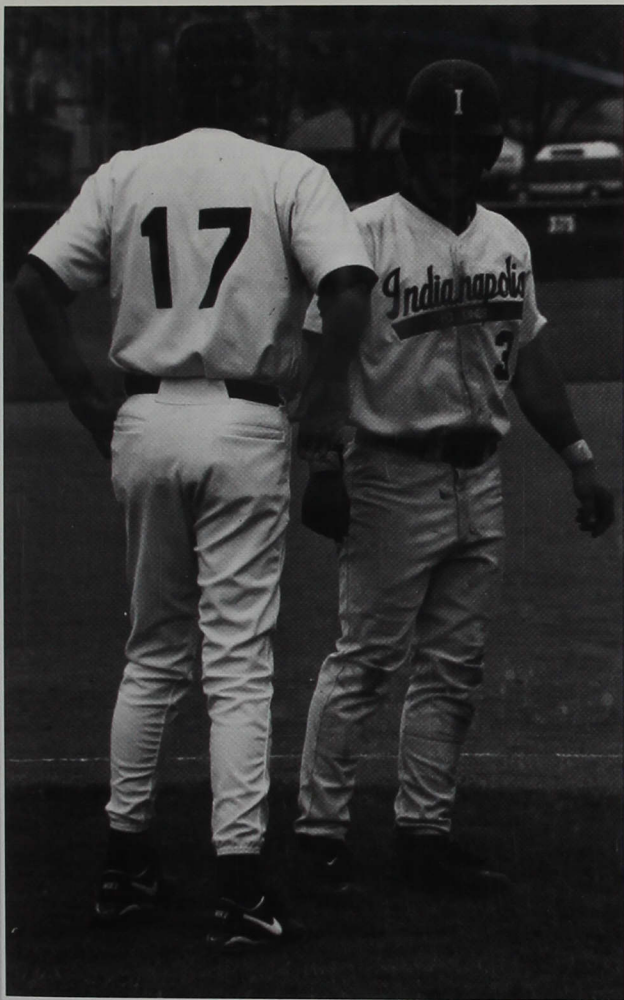

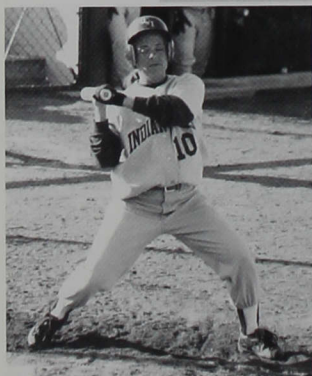

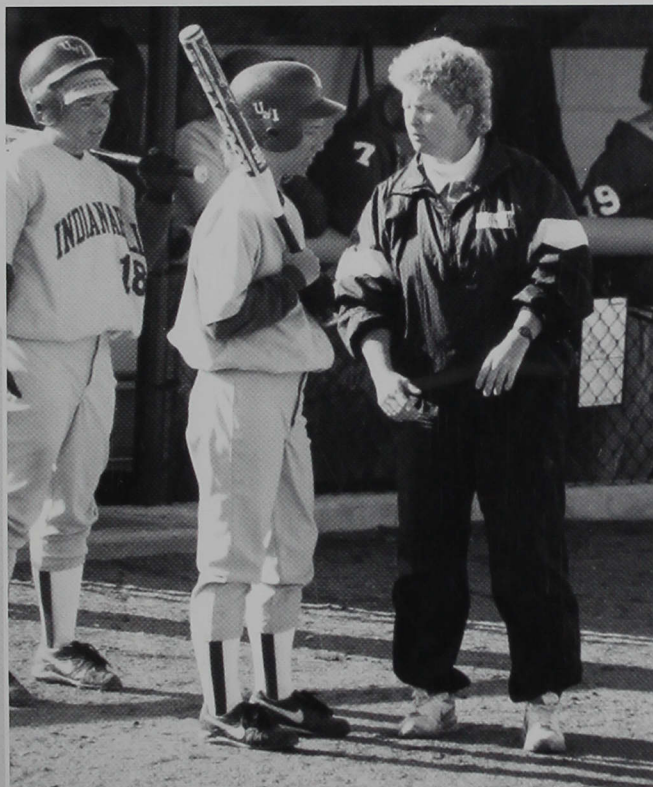

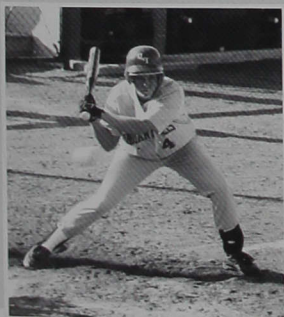

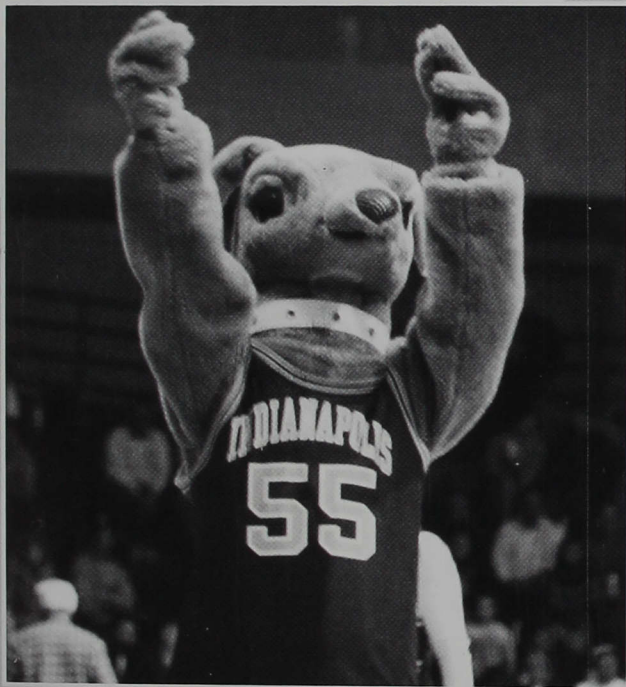

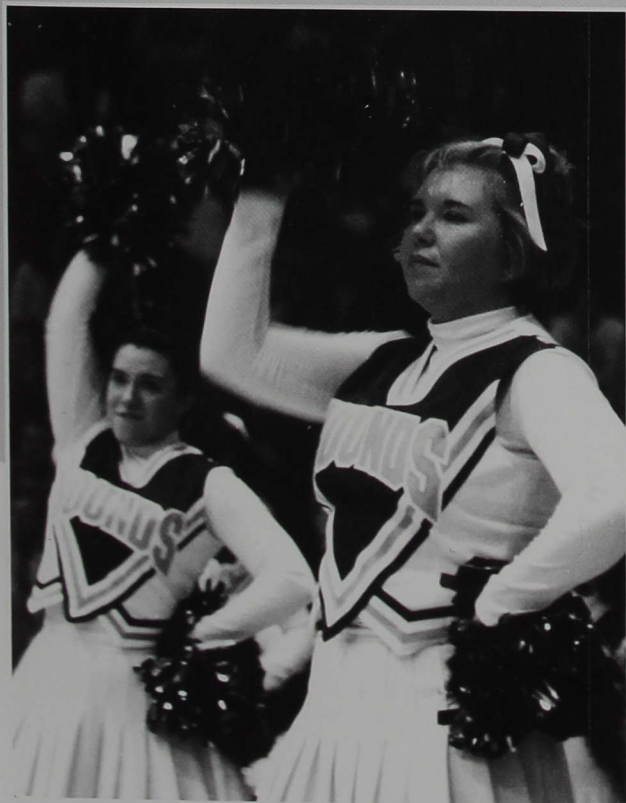
