

Ted Polk stays cool and collected despite the heat from the grill. As always, Ted and his staff did an outstanding job of preparing enough food to feed hundreds of people.









These students gather around President Lantz following the 1996 Flag Day ceremony, held annually to honor the university's international community.


































Theatre student Suzie David is a happy camper during rehearsals for *Little Shop*. Suzie was both deck captain and mic wrangler for the production.








































