Transfer of credit is subject to the following conditions:

1. A maximum of 15 graduate hours may be transferred from another institution. The 15-hour limit is specific to transfer credits from other institutions. Students who completed other graduate programs at the University of Indianapolis may transfer additional hours if course content is determined to be equivalent and if the proposed transfer does not conflict with criteria 2-6 below.
2. Transfer of credit will only be given for graduate course work in which a grade of B or better was obtained.
3. All transferred graduate credit must have been completed within five(5) years prior to a student's admission into the program.
4. Transfer of credit may only be given for prior graduate course work judged to be equivalent to required courses offered in the Clinical Psychology Doctoral Program at the University of Indianapolis in which the student is enrolled.
5. Transfer of credit is not granted for practica, internships, thesis, dissertation, elective, or concentration classes. Transfer credit will not be offered for GPSY-650(Doctoral Practicum/Seminar); GPSY-651(Advanced Doctoral Practicum/Seminar); GPSY-653/654(Doctoral Traineeship/Elective Practicum); or GPSY-690(Dissertation Research). We consider these courses to be fundamental to the program's character and must certify that students have received training according to those standards. Transfer credit will not be offered for GPSY-520(Ethics, Professional Standards and Legal Issues) unless completed at UIndy and taught by a core faculty member.
6. Implications for time to completion: Typically, students with transfer credit complete the program in 5 years. In rare cases, transfer credit may reduce students' time to completion.
