- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.7 on a scale of 4.0.

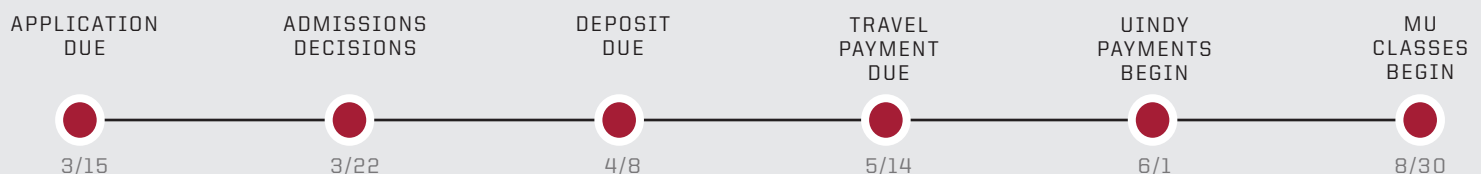
HOW DO I APPLY?

- Complete the online application form;

- Write and submit a personal statement.

UINDY/MU SUPPORT SYSTEM

- Pre-departure orientation and guidance from UIndy’s School of Education and the Center for Global Engagement throughout the entirety of the program.
- Coordination of travel arrangements, payment remissions, and course registration by UIndy.
- Once in Ireland, the MU International Office will provide orientation and student coordinators specifically assigned to support ESAP Scholars.
