**NOTES:**

- Research Experience can be taken for 0.5 credit per semester for multiple semesters. Students are required to complete a total of 4 credits of Research Experience, culminating in a final research product to graduate.
- The Archeology major requires a minimum of 56 hours.
- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Archeology Major.
- The Bachelor of Science Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.
