Concentration

- ECED 326 Integrated Learning Across All Content Areas (3)
- ECED 384 Assessments and Advocacy (3)
- ECED 401 Creating Global Understanding and Professionalism (3)
- ECED 402 Administration of a Children's Center (3)

Total hours required for Early Childhood Education concentration: 18 hours

NOTES:

- This concentration is open to all baccalaureate-degree majors at UIndy.
- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the early education minor.
- Successful completion of this concentration **does not** lead to an Indiana state licensure for education.
