2025-2026 Curriculum Guide for Education Minor and Concentration, Non-Licensure (EDUC)

Minor or Concentration

Required Courses (available every semester) (9 hours):

- **EDUC 100** Exploration in Education (3)
- **EDUC 203** Psychology of Development, Learning, & Instruction (3)
- **EDUC 204** Field Experience: Psychology of Development, Learning, & Instruction (0)
(co-req EDUC 203 for those needing a placement)
- **EDUC 290** Teaching & Learning in a Diverse Society (3)

Electives:

Students pursuing a minor should complete 9 hours from the following. Students pursuing a concentration should complete 6 hours from the following:

- **COMM 201** Classroom Communication (non-EDUC required for education majors) (3)
- **EDUC 199** Special Topics (3)
- **EDUC 272** Intro to Learners with Mild Disabilities (2)
- **EDUC 255** Technology & Student Support Systems (2)
- **EDUC 300** Social, Political, Philosophical Foundations in US Education (3)
- **EDUC 385** Classroom Management & Positive Behavior Support (2)
- Other pre-approved Education (EDUC), Early Childhood (ECED), Elementary (ELED), or Secondary Education (SCED) courses.

NOTES:

- The EDUC minor requires a minimum of 18 credit hours.
- The EDUC concentration requires a minimum of 15 credit hours.
- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the EDUC minor or concentration.
- Completion of the education minor or concentration does not lead to any state licensure in education.
