- **KINS 440** Epidemiology (3) *Prerequisites: KINS 204 OR MATH 220 OR MATH 245*

Term VI (7 weeks):

- **KINS 452** Intro to Public Health Policy & Health Systems Management (3) *Prereq: KINS 260*
- **KINS 421** Healthcare Management (3) *Prerequisites: KINS 260 & KINS 390*

Term VII (15 weeks):

- **KINS 491** Internship in Health Sciences (6) *Prerequisite: KINS 390, KINS 361(HQI), KINS 332 (PHE), KINS 452, KINS 440, KINS 421(HM)*

NOTES:

- Each course is offered in a 7-week term except for KINS 491, which will be offered in a standard 15-week term.
- The Health Sciences major requires a minimum of 41 hours.
- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Health Sciences Major.
- The Bachelor of Science Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.
- Students who have completed the Indiana College Core (ICC) are waived from the UIndy general education core except for the following: the Religion general education requirement and the Modern Language requirement, as determined by their degree (Competency through 101 for the BS in the College of Health Sciences). See the General Education Core Guide for additional degree requirements if the ICC is not earned. A UIndy Online admissions counselor will work with you to map out your courses.
- A student may complete more than one major as long as each major has at least 24 discrete hours. Please see the Academic Catalog for additional details.
