**Required Courses (7 hours):**

- **MENG 120** Engineering Graphics (1)
- **MENG 210** Statics (3)
- **MENG 220** Thermodynamics (3)

**Take a minimum of 11 hours from the following courses:**

- **MENG/PHYS 230** Lab Instrumentation (3)
- **EENG 405** Controls I (3)
- **ENGR/PHYS 360** Dynamics (3)
- Any 300 or 400-level MENG courses

Total Hours: 18 (minimum)

**NOTES:**

- The Mechanical Engineering Minor requires a minimum of 18 hours.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Mechanical Engineering Minor.
- Students are required to complete the necessary prerequisites with a grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher to enroll in the courses listed here to complete the minor.
