Minor

Required Courses for Elementary Education (ELED) majors:

Total hours required for MI concentration in Secondary Education: 6 hours outside the SED2 co-major + 17.5 hours that are embedded into required classes for the SED2 co-major (listed above) = total 23.5 hours

Total hours required for MI concentration in Elementary Education: 6 hours for Supervised Teaching Mild Interventions outside the ELED major are required. All other hours are embedded into required classes for the ELED major = 22 total hours

NOTES:

- This minor is only open to ELED and SED2 majors
- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the MI concentration.
- Successful completion of this minor, in addition to any requirements mandated by the Indiana Department of Education, leads to recommendation for licensure
