**\*\*In order to be accepted into the Equivalency Certification in Music Therapy program, students must have a music degree from a NASM accredited university, and complete an entrance audition into the Department of Music. Prior to the completion of the equivalency program students must meet acceptable competency levels on piano, guitar, percussion and voice. Students must also have taken PSY 120 – Intro to Psychology prior to beginning the equivalency program.**

**Please note the following:**

**ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- An Audition/Interview is required before admission into the music therapy equivalency certificate program.
- PSY 120: Intro to Psychology must be taken prior to beginning.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- A grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Music Major.
- The Music Therapy certificate requires a minimum of 30% music therapy and clinical foundations coursework on top of the previously earned 20-25% general education core coursework and 45-50% music core coursework from music degree already held.
- The Equivalency Certificate in Music Therapy requires a minimum of 31 hours.
