Concentration

Required Courses (12 hours):

- **PSY 301** Neuroscience Foundations (3)
- **PSY 302** Biological Basis of Perception and Movement (3)
- **PSY 303** Cognitive Neuroscience (3)
- **PSY 304** Clinical Neuropathology (3)

Elective Options (encouraged, but not required):

- **PSY 340** Readings in Biol-Bases of Behavior (3)
- **PSY 460** Research Practicum in Psychology (2)
- **PSY 499** Internship in Psychology (1-4)
- **INTD 205** Interdisciplinary Internship (1-3)
- **BIOL 460** Topics in Biology (1-4)

NOTES:

- The Neuroscience concentration requires a minimum of 12 credit hours.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Neuroscience concentration.
- Prerequisites for PSY 301 are: 1) either BIOL 103 & 104, BIOL 155, or BIOL 159, 2) BIOL 165, 3) CHEM 150 & 151, and 4) CHEM 160 & 161.
- Additional prerequisite for PSY 304 is PSY 120 Introduction to Psychology.
- This concentration is available to any student who meets the eligibility requirements for the courses listed in the concentration; however, courses (other than PSY 301) completed in order to earn the neuroscience concentration may **not** be counted toward the Psychology major or minor requirements.
