NOTES:

- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Performing Arts minor.
- A Performing Arts minor requires a minimum of 19 credit hours.
- Communication majors may not “double dip” elective course options
- Additional courses may count toward the minor as approved
- This program may require attendance in both day and extended programs classes
