Required Courses (12 credits):

Electives: Minimum of 8 credits from the following courses:

- LANG 300 Languages without Borders (1-4)
- LANG 324 Masterpieces in Translation (3)

- ST 299 Spring Term Travel to a Spanish Speaking Country (3)

NOTES:

- The 4 hours of SPAN 101 do NOT count toward the Applied Spanish Minor.
- The Applied Spanish minor requires a minimum of 20 hours, excluding the 4 hours of SPAN 101. NOTE: Students who take the placement exam and get placed at the 204-300 levels could get up to 8 credits back toward the minor.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Spanish Minor.
