Bachelor of Arts

Required Courses: 30 credits

- SPAN 201 Spanish Language and Culture III (4) (or placement equivalent)
- SPAN 204 Intermediate Spanish (4) (or placement equivalent)
- SPAN 300 Spanish Writing & Correspondence (4)
- SPAN 310 Spanish Conversation (4)
- SPAN 317 Spanish Culture & Civilization (4)
- SPAN 422 Spanish Translation (4) **OR**
- SPAN 423 Spanish for the Professions (4)
- LANG 485 Capstone Seminar (2)

* The 4 hours of SPAN 101 do NOT count toward the Spanish major or the Spanish major combined with a Teaching major.

TRACK 1: Spanish Major Only

Choose 4 credits hours from:

- LANG 300 Languages without Borders (1-4)
- LANG 324 Masterpieces in Translation (3)
- LANG 398 Multilingual Translation/Conversation (3)
- LANG 480 Selected Cross-cultural Topics (3)
- LANG 450 Internships in Modern Languages (1-8)
- SPAN 435 Hispanic Literature (4)
- SPAN 480 Selected Topics (4)
- ST 299 Spring Term Travel to a Spanish Speaking Country (3)

TRACK 2: Spanish Major combined with Teaching Major

- SPAN 435 Hispanic Literature (4)
- LANG 450 Internship in Modern Languages (2 credit hours) **OR**
 2 credit hours (2) in a Spanish- speaking country

NOTES:

- The Applied Spanish major requires a minimum of 34 credit hours, excluding the 4 credit hours of SPAN 101.
- The Applied Spanish major combined with a Teaching major requires a minimum of 36 credit hours, excluding the 4 credit hours of SPAN 101.
- A grade of C- (1.7 on a 4.0 scale) or higher is required in all courses applying toward the Spanish major or Spanish major combined with a Teaching major.
- Students who take the placement exam and get placed at the 204-300 levels awarded up to 8 credits back toward the major.
- Students completing the major who took the placement exam and were placed at the 300 level or above are required to fulfill the remaining credits for the major with 300 and 400 level courses.
- The Bachelor of Arts Degree requires a minimum of 120 hours.
- See the General Education Core Guide for additional course requirements.
- A student may complete more than one major as long as each major has at least 24 discrete hours. Please see the Academic Catalog for additional details.
